Statement Regarding California Proposition 65 Concerning Sensoteq Products

Proposition 65, officially known as the California State Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, aims to protect Californian citizens from significant exposure to chemicals known to the state to cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive harm. Californian Proposition 65 obligates businesses operating in California to provide clear and reasonable warnings before knowingly and intentionally exposing Californians to chemicals that are listed in the Proposition 65 list.

To the present and best of our knowledge, based upon the information available to us, some of our products contain Proposition 65 listed substances. Although these chemicals are incorporated in some of our products, there is no exposure route, such as contact with skin, being ingested with food or drink, or inhalation in the normal or foreseeable use intended. Therefore, a warning label that our products contain chemicals that may cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive harm is not required.

In response to a customer request, Sensoteq Ltd can provide the relevant detailed information on chemicals contained in our product. By requesting this information, Californians can make informed decisions about their risk of exposure to these chemicals.

People or companies operating in California, intending to use Sensoteq Ltd products for different uses, other than the normal recommended product usage, may cause exposure risk to Proposition 65 listed chemicals if present. When used as intended Sensoteq Ltd products should not intentionally release any Proposition 65 listed chemicals. To mitigate and reduce the risk of exposure, Sensoteq Ltd recommends use of approved safety equipment alongside the relevant risk assessment for installation. These precautions should be taken for occupational uses including but not limited to destructive physical analysis.
